Dear Mount Sinai Beth Israel Patient,

As you may have heard, the Mount Sinai Health System has received approval from the Department of Health to close the 16th Street campus of Mount Sinai Beth Israel (MSBI), and we plan to close it at 11:59 pm on Wednesday, March 26. We are sending this letter to all patients who have sought care at 16th Street during the past 18 months to share more information and begin to answer any questions you may have. **The closure will only impact Mount Sinai Beth Israel's 16th Street campus. All of our other facilities in Lower Manhattan—such as Mount Sinai-Union Square, the Mount Sinai-Behavioral Health Center, and all of our physician practice locations—will remain open.**

Until the closure, we will continue to provide Emergency Department services at the 16th Street location.

To serve our community, we will open a **new** Urgent Care facility on March 26 on East 14th Street at Second Avenue. Mount Sinai-Urgent Care, East 14th Street, will be open 24 hours a day and 7 days a week and staffed by board certified doctors who can treat most of your minor injuries and illnesses, such as allergies, asthma attacks, cuts that need stitches, earaches, eye infections, flu, sprains, and rashes. This will be complemented by our Virtual Urgent Care Program, <https://www.mountsinai.org/virtualurgentcare>.

As we approach the closing date, we hope you will consider visiting one of Mount Sinai's many other care facilities. In recent years, Mount Sinai has significantly expanded access and care throughout Lower Manhattan by creating new facilities or upgrading our existing services. These include:

- The Martha Stewart Center for Living at Union Square
- Mount Sinai-Urgent Care, East 14th Street
- Mount Sinai-Urgent Care, Union Square
- Mount Sinai – National Jewish Health Respiratory Institute

- The Blavatnik Family Chelsea Medical Center



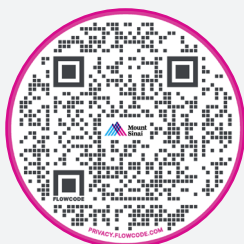

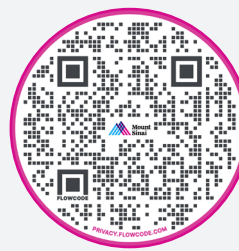
